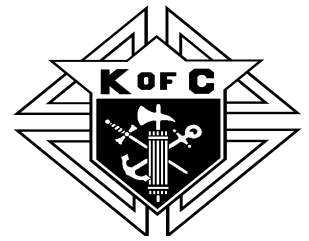

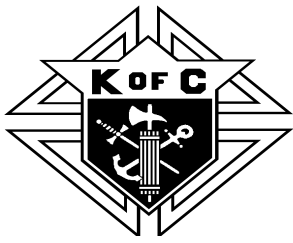

LECTURER'S CORNER

Lost Gospels or False Gospels?

The Knights of Columbus and Sacred Heart Faith Formation invite you to attend a presentation and discussion entitled "Lost Gospels or False Gospels?" on Saturday, February 21st, at 10 AM in the parish hall. Refreshments will be served. This program is intended for adult faith formation, but families are welcome. What will we cover? Christians and many non-Christians have long accepted Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John—the four gospels of the New Testament—as the only reliable accounts of the life and teaching of Jesus of Nazareth. Recent media stories and certain best-selling books have alerted the public to alternative writings about Jesus, leading many people—including many believers—to wonder why we should consider only the four New Testament gospels as "gospel truth." Was there a conspiracy in the early Church to suppress these writings? Do they add anything to our understanding of Jesus?

The alternative writings about Jesus bear the names of such prominent early Christians as Peter, Thomas, Mary Magdalene, Judas, James, and Andrew. Some of these writings purport to contain "secret" teachings of Jesus, to recount his childhood or to fill in other gaps in the story of Jesus. Some contradict the New Testament. What should informed believers and nonbelievers make of them? Were they written by disciples of Jesus as they claim? How do they compare with the New Testament gospels? Are these works "lost gospels" or "false gospels"?

In this thought-provoking presentation, top scholars of early Christian writings answer these and other crucial questions. They discuss the relationship between these works and the New Testament. The experts also explore Gnostic writings such as the "Gospel of Thomas" and the "Gospel of Judas", and they reveal startling facts about the groups who composed them. Anyone who is interested in the truth about Jesus and the early Church must attend *Lost Gospels or False Gospels?*

Featuring an Ignatius Press DVD with Jesuit Father Mitch Pacwa, Dr. Craig Evans, Dr. Ben Witherington, III, Dr. Timothy Gray, Dr. Edward Sri, Dr. Amy-Jill Levine, Dr. Craig Blomberg, and Dr. Gary Habermas. George Darnell and Ted Zuenzes will facilitate a discussion of the DVD.

Copies of these gospels will be available to browse and handouts on the formation of the Old and New Testaments will be distributed.

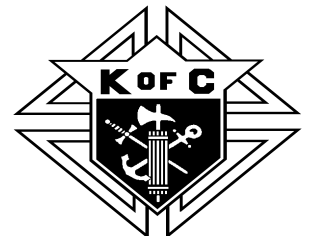






- DONATION:** Donation is \$10.00. Each ticket is valid for 5 weeks of the racing season starting March 22 and ending April 26, 2009.
- FILL OUT STUB:** Participants must PRINT LEGIBLY their name, address, and telephone number on the stub. Put your name on the bottom line of the stub. You keep the stub and give the player the ticket.
- MONEY:** Turn in all stubs with the collected money. (see below)
- 4-DRIVERS WEEKLY:** For the purpose of this fundraiser, we use only 24 race car drivers. Tickets have two sets of 4-Drivers each week and the 4-Drivers change weekly. No two tickets have the same 4-Drivers in any one week.
- DATES:** Week #1 is March 22nd. Week #2 is March 29th. Week #3 is April 5th, etc.
