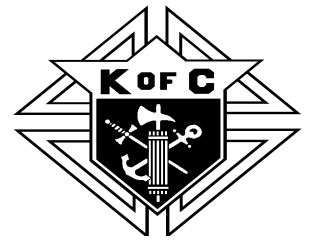

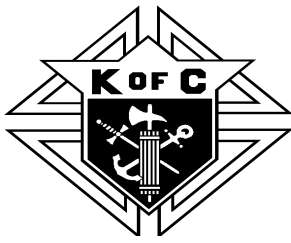
KOVAR

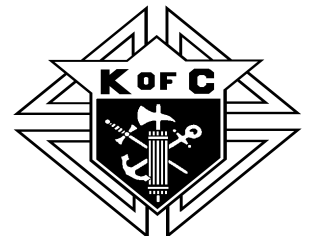
