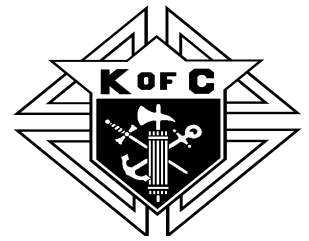

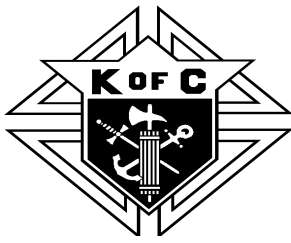
KNIGHT OF THE MONTH

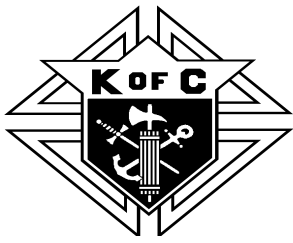

PRO-LIFE

As many of you know, the Virginia Knights of Columbus were heavily involved in the campaign to authorize pro-life "Choose Life" license plates for use in Virginia. These specialty plates must be authorized by the Virginia legislature and approved by the Governor; and their authorization and approval came about largely through the efforts of State Senator Ken Cuccinelli, a member of the Knights of Columbus from Centreville.

The Choose Life license plates are now available for purchase. To purchase your Choose Life plates on-line, Click on this link to order directly from DMV. Note that you will need your vehicle's title number and Vehicle Identification Number (VIN). Both of these numbers are found on your vehicle Identification card. Note also that persons can purchase the Choose Life plates directly from their local DMV office, should they not wish to make the purchase on-line.

Please ask all your friends to show their support for life, and the Pregnancy Centers around Virginia, by purchasing the Choose Life plates. Help make the Choose Life plates the most popular ones on Virginia's roads!

KOVAR UPDATE

Brother Knights, we do perform this labor of love each year. Below is just a small example of what the dollars go for – thanks to PGK Brother Jeff for serving on the board and helping make these grants possible.

\$13,000 to Capernaum's Day Camp, which will enable 30 young people with intellectual disabilities (and their buddies) to attend day camp in Chesapeake, Virginia. They will have the opportunity to engage in physical exercise in a loving and caring environment, assisted by their buddies.

\$5,444 to St. Mark Catholic School to purchase books and software to assist students with intellectual disabilities. Supporting 6 students, but reusable in the future, this purchase will allow St. Marks to charge a lower tuition, and allow more intellectually disabled students to get a Catholic education.

\$7,490 to M.T. Sorrell, Inc. in Blairs, VA. This grant will allow a group home with 13 clients with Intellectual Disability to purchase water heaters, refrigerator, washer/dryer, freezer and a gas stove.

\$5,011 to Northern Virginia Training Center, Fairfax, VA. This grant will allow the center to replace outdoor furniture that is rotting or inadequate. NVTC serves 175 clients with intellectual disability in the Northern Virginia area, but the nature area is open to anyone with ID to walk the trail.

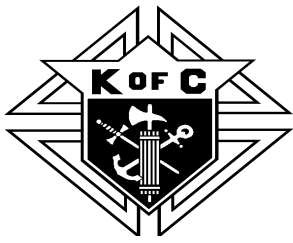
\$10, 668 to Intellectual Disabilities Agency of the New River Valley, Christiansburg, VA. This grant will provide for the transportation of clients with intellectual disabilities to educational, recreational and social events in the area.

\$19,935 to Scottsdale Estates Group Home, Inc. in Fredericksburg, VA. This grant will help furnish a new six bed group home in the Fredericksburg area. The home is scheduled to open in January, 2010.

\$20,000 to Heart Havens, Inc. in Richmond, VA. This grant will provide furnishings for a new home with space for four clients with intellectual disabilities.

As you can see, these grants totaling more than \$81,500 were made to a myriad of organizations across the state. Thanks for your support of KOVAR.
